

ANSSELL GLOVE SIZING CHART



FIND THE RIGHT GLOVE SIZE MEASURE CIRCUMFERENCE

Correct sizing is essential for ensuring glove comfort. The ideal way to determine size is with a dressmaker's cloth tape. Use it to measure the circumference of the palm of the hand at its widest point, in millimeters. Cross-reference that measurement against the table provided here. Most gloves with knitwrist are color coded for size identification as below.



| Size | Hand circumference | Cuff colour | |
|------|--------------------|-------------|------------|
| XXS | 5 | 137 mm | Pink |
| XS | 6 | 152 mm | Purple |
| S | 7 | 178 mm | Red |
| M | 8 | 203 mm | Yellow |
| L | 9 | 229 mm | Brown |
| XL | 10 | 254 mm | Black |
| XXL | 11 | 279 mm | Light blue |
| XXXL | 12 | 295 mm | Green |
